The image is made up of two photographs for which we chose a constraint, which was to photograph one tree each.

Looking at the results, we were surprised to see that communication networks had been framed with the trees, without consulting each other.

The tree structure of the gallery's website inspired this image.



Here is some news about the gallery's website.

First of all, we publish ads on the Unige and Epfl websites, on anibis, ricardo, and we also post an offer at the Uni Batelle. Only one girl replied, Kim. Then, through word of mouth, we find Celia and meet her. Kim is too inexperienced in PHP code (1st year at Epfl). Célia works only with the Wordpress CMS robot which constrains the programming parameters. Then Celia disappears for two months.

The essential questions are unresolved: to do in Wordpress or in code, with a girl rather than a boy?

We then sent about ten offers to local companies, which resulted in various quotes. Two price ranges emerged, between three and six thousand francs with robots or between ten and eleven thousand in code.

We meet a programmer who gives us an appointment in his living room. He codes in Joomla but we don't get along. Paternalistic, lecturing, everything we hate!

Then we move on with Célia who is motivated. She studied fine arts and immediately understood our project. She gives us an estimate of between three thousand two hundred and three thousand five hundred francs, but without the caddy.

We decided at that point that e-commerce would be set up at a later date.

Via Infomaniak we sent our offer to fifty-two companies and received several quotes that were too expensive: CMS around three thousand and code around ten thousand francs.

Some companies called us but never sent us a quote.

A friend who advises us insists on the evolutionary quality of a coded site rather than the use of robots which are difficult to adapt in the future. He promises us a quote that never arrives.

At this point, we think that perhaps cloning another friend's site might be a cheap and adaptable solution with a Bootstrap coded base.

Finally, a professional company makes us an offer for two thousand nine hundred francs. On July 6th we meet the boss who makes us happy by answering all our requests. We sign a contract with them on July 20th. They are guys, but, considering the price for code, we choose this option. Since then, we have been working with Enoxone on a just-in-time basis ;-)
